## Frequently-asked questions

### How is BravoAdvantage being funded after the 2017-18 financial year?

HPV's 'supply chain excellence' program for Victoria's public health sector proposes a technological solution to help streamline procurement processes, improve supply chain efficiency and reduce costs. Successful implementation of the program will see HPV meet health services' ongoing licence fees in rolling out BravoAdvantage.

### How much does BravoAdvantage cost?

BravoAdvantage's implementation costs vary significantly and depend on individual health service configuration and implementation requirements. A basic implementation involves a one-off cost of around \$10,000; a complex platform will attract a single charge in the range of \$50,000-plus.

### What do I need to do to get BravoAdvantage working for me?

Health services interested in implementing BravoAdvantage should contact HPV to determine their specific requirements. HPV and BravoAdvantage will work with you to develop an individual quote for implementation and a practical plan for roll-out.

### How much time does it take?

The BravoAdvantage implementation timeframe

depends on a number of factors including configuration and resource availability. From the first discussions about scope to having a fully-functional system up and running will take between one and six months.
